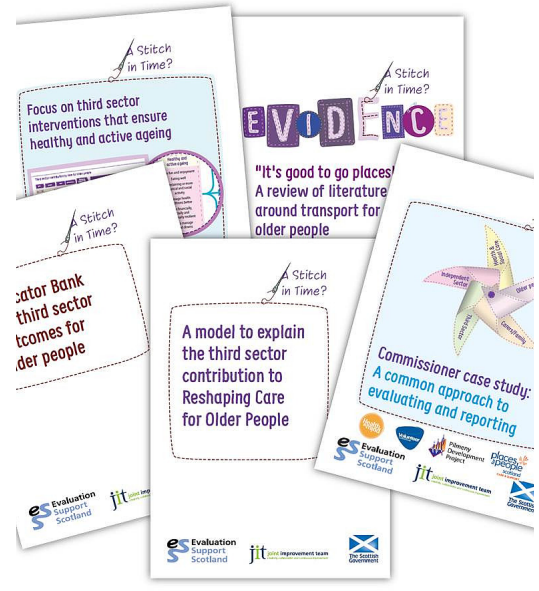


Evidence for what?

“ If decisions were only to be based on available strong evidence of effective actions, the result would often be a very small number and range of actions. Andrew Tannahill (2008) ”

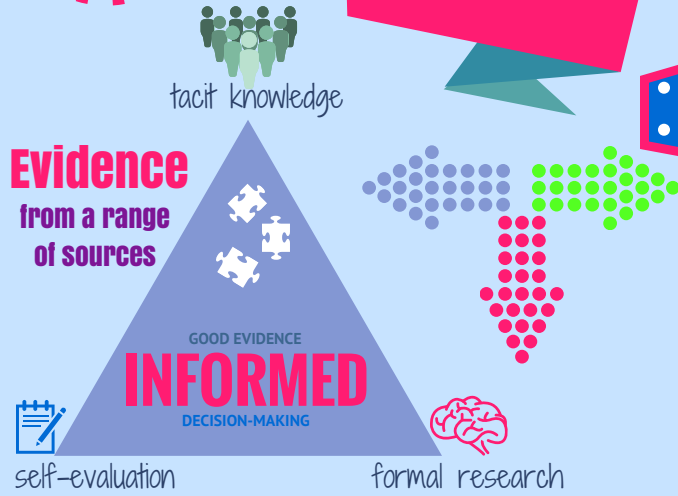


What we use in Scotland

NOT A HIERARCHY

Evidence:

- Is Co-produced and
- Involves the service user



“ In our experience, evidence generated by self-evaluation is more likely to be used and acted on ”



our framework

GOOD ENOUGH EVIDENCE is

- T**ransparent: clear methods, limitations acknowledged
- R**elevant: up to date, appropriate
- E**nough: evidence strength vs proportionality
- B**elievable: accurate, representative, reliable
- L**egitimate: coming from the right sources
